Deposits are nonrefundable if you cancel for any reason. However, deposits may be transferable to a future program. In the event that we must cancel the course, all monies paid, including your deposit, will be refunded. Full tuition payment is required by the registration deadline (unless you make arrangements to pay it at class time), or you may forfeit your reserved spot. If you cancel for any reason after the deadline, refunds may vary, depending on how much notice you give and where we are in our timeline. We will do our best to be fair.

**Payment/Pricing Options and course information:**

The cost for the entire 4 weekend course is a sliding scale and we offer a discount for early registration on or before November 15. The sliding scale cost is \$895 - \$1,200 if registered on or before November 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010, and \$995 - \$1,200 after November 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010. It is the student's responsibility to discern the price that best suits his or her financial situation and Blue Ridge Permaculture will honor that amount as fair. Balance in Full is due by the first day of class, January 15, 2010.

A few work trade positions are available for partial tuition; inquire soon about work trade guidelines and availability. The work-trade application deadline ends on December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010, and limited scholarships may be available, inquire for details.

Early registration for the course is encouraged as space is limited. Lunches and snacks will be provided during the Design Course. Students will be responsible for their own overnight accommodations off-site, as well as transportation to and from the site.
